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### **AN ACT Changing Name of Dance, Incorporated.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. Change of Name.** The name of Dance, Incorporated, a corporation organized under the Maine Revised Statutes of 1964, Title 13, chapter 81, is changed to Maine State Ballet.

**Sec. 2. Copy recorded.** A copy of this Act shall be recorded in the records of the Secretary of State.

### STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of the bill is reflected in the title and to obtain legislative approval for the use of the word "Maine" in the name.
