**RESOLVE, Providing Retirement Benefits Under the State Retirement Law
for Earl A. Haines of Brunswick.**

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, Earl A. Haines has suffered permanent injury and disability arising out of the performance of his duties as a Maine State Police Officer; and

Whereas, the following legislation is vitally necessary to provide Earl A. Haines with those benefits and financial resources to which he would be entitled had he not been so injured; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine, and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it

Earl A. Haines; retirement pension. Resolved: That the trustees of the retirement system are authorized and directed to pay Detective Earl A. Haines retirement at the rate of the current pay of a detective of the Maine State Police; and he is to receive those pay raises to which an active detective may become entitled from time to time for the rest of his life; and he is to receive those medical benefits to which an active member of the Maine State Police is entitled. Payment shall be retroactive to October 13, 1972.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this resolve is reflected in the title.
