STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Regulations Governing Horsepower of Boats on Certain Inland Waters.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 38, § 231, sub-§ 4, ¶ D, amended. The first sentence of paragraph D of subsection 4 of section 231 of Title 38 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 47 of chapter 403 of the public laws of 1971, is amended to read as follows:

Regulations governing the horsepower of motors used to propel watercraft on inland waters of less than 50 100 acres in area. The acreage of said waters shall be those acreages as determined from data available in the records of the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase the size of waters in which regulations may be promulgated regulating the size of outboard motors used on certain waters.
