## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 106TH LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to H. P. 58, L. D. 70, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Fees for Forest Lands and Wild Lands Posted Against Trespass."

Amend said bill by striking out the title and inserting in place thereof: 'AN ACT Relating to Forest Lands and Wild Lands Posted Against Trespass.'

Further amend said bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'R. S., T. 17, § 3860, additional. Title 17 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 3860 to read as follows: § 3860. Great pond; access or egress

No person on foot shall be denied access or egress over unimproved land to a great pond. The Attorney General shall upon complaint of a person being denied said access or egress, if in his judgment the public interest so requires, prosecute criminally or civilly any person who denies such right of access or egress. Any person violating this section shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100 and by imprisonment for not more than 90 days.'

## Statement of Fact

It is the intent of this amendment to give access and egress to a great pond.
