AN ACT Increasing Salaries of County Officers of Somerset County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The 14th paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, which relates to Somerset County, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

Somerset County: County commissioners, ~~\$1,500~~ \$1,650; chairman, ~~\$1,750~~ \$1,850; clerk of courts, ~~\$6,250~~ \$7,000; county attorney, \$8,000; assistant county attorney, \$5,000; county treasurer, ~~\$2,250~~ \$3,150; sheriff, ~~\$6,250~~ \$7,000; register of deeds, ~~\$6,250~~ \$7,000; judge of probate, ~~\$6,250~~ \$7,000; register of probate, ~~\$6,250~~ \$7,000;

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to allow for increases due to higher costs of living and to bring salaries more into line with existing conditions.
