COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A "to H.P. 75, L.D. 88, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Possession of Salmon, Trout, Togue or Black Bass."

Amend said Bill in the last line before the Statement of
Fact (the same in L.D.) by striking out the underlined words
"the legal length" and inserting in place thereof the underlined
words ' or greater than the legal length'

may be kept if the dressed length is equal to the legal length.
