# STATE OF MAINE

# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

### RESOLVE Providing Funds for Development of a State Park at Gleason Point, Town of Perry.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, resolves do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless passed as emergencies; and

Whereas, the State of Maine owns about 120 acres at Gleason Point, Washington County; and

Whereas, the tourist trade is one of Maine's greatest economic assets and should be encouraged as much as possible; and

Whereas, the following legislation is vitally necessary to encourage tourism in eastern Maine for the season of 1973; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine, and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it

State Park at Gleason Point, Perry; appropriation for. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$31,000 for the development and construction of a day use state park at Gleason Point, Town of Perry, including, but not limited to, access road, parking, picnic areas with supporting facilities and limited boat access.

**Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this resolve is reflected in the emergency preamble. The total cost of the project is estimated at \$59,000 of which \$28,000 would be eligible for federal reimbursement.
