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AN ACT Relating to Use of Power Boats on Sourdnahunk  
Lake, Piscataquis County.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 38, § 251, additional. Title 38 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 251 to read as follows:

§ 251. —Sourdnahunk Lake; use of power boats

No person, except officers empowered to enforce this subchapter, shall operate a motorboat or canoe having more than 10 horsepower on Sourdnahunk Lake, in T. 4, R. 10, T. 4, R. 11, T. 5, R. 10 and T. 5, R. 11, Piscataquis County.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to prohibit the operation of boats of more than 10 horsepower on Sourdnahunk Lake, Piscataquis County.
