AN ACT Requiring Municipal Consultation on Aid to
Dependent Children Applications.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 22, § 374I-A, additional. Title 22 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 374I-A to read as follows.

§ 374I-A. **Municipal consultation**

Before granting aid under this chapter, the Department of Health and Welfare shall consult with the overseers of the poor or the department of public welfare of the municipality of residence or settlement, as appropriate for advice and assistance as to the applicant's need for the aid requested.
