AN ACT Providing for Rest Rooms in Laundromats.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 26, c. 6-A, additional. Title 26 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new chapter 6-A to read as follows:

CHAPTER 6-A

LAUNDROMATS

§ 585. Laundromats

All automatic laundries and automatic dry cleaning establishments, or any combination thereof, shall be provided with separate rest rooms for men and women.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide for the well-being of patrons of laundromats.
