**AN ACT Permitting Sunday Hunting of Rabbits.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 12, § 2454, amended.** The first sentence of section 2454 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 47 of chapter 425 of the public laws of 1969, is further amended to read as follows:

It shall be unlawful to hunt wild birds or wild animals on Sunday, **except that it shall be lawful to hunt wild hares or rabbits on Sunday during the open season.**

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is reflected in the title.
