**AN ACT Providing a Full-time Office for Registration and Licenses for
Operation of Motor Vehicles in the Town of Lincoln.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Town of Lincoln; motor vehicle registration office. The Secretary of State shall maintain a full-time office at Lincoln to carry out his duties relating to applications for registration of, and licenses for, the operation of motor vehicles.

Sec. 1. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Highway Fund to the Secretary of State, Motor Vehicle Division, the sum of \$35,045 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:

STATEMENT OF FACT

In view of the present necessity for distant travel for registration and licenses for operation of motor vehicles, it is the intent of this Act to establish a state motor vehicle office in the Town of Lincoln, which can serve an approximate area of 40 square miles.
