COMMITTEE AMENDMENT"A " to H.P. 89, L.D. 109, Bill, "AN ACT Creating Sagadahoc County Commissioner Districts."

Amend said bill by striking out in the 5th line (3rd and 4th lines of L.D.) after the amending clause, the underlined word and punctuation "Richmond," and inserting in place thereof, the following underlined words and punctuation: 'Bowdoinham, Georgetown, Arrowsic,'

Further amend said bill by striking out all of the 9th, 10th and 11th lines after the enacting clause (7th, 8th and 9th lines of L.D.) and inserting in place thereof, the following:

'Commissioner District number 2 consisting of the municipalities of Woolwich, Phippsburg and Richmond as well as Bath wards 1 and 2;'

Further amend said bill in "Sec. 1" by inserting at the end before the period of the next to the last paragraph, the following underlined words" 'and the municipality of West Bath'

The intent of this amendment is to provide each County Commissioner District with even disposition of population.
