COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 91, L.D. 112, Bill, "AN ACT
Increasing Minimum Wages."

Amend said Bill in the 4th and 5th lines from the end before
the Statement of Fact (5th and 6th lines from the end in L.D.)
by striking out the word and figures "September 23, 1971" and
inserting in place thereof the following: ' ~~September-23, 1971~~
October 15, 1973'

Further amend said Bill in the 3rd line from the end before the
Statement of Fact (4th line from the end in the L.D.) by striking
out the underlined figures "\$2.25" and inserting in place thereof the
following underlined figures '\$3'

Statement of Fact

Due to the fact that the Federal Government is expected to
initiate increases to \$2. or more, it is the intent of this
amendment to reflect corresponding changes.
