COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 95, L.D.116, Bill, "AN ACT  
Relating to Fees Received by State Officials and Employees."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§8-I." in the 6th line  
(5th line of L.D.) by inserting after the underlined word "Fund"  
the following underlined words: 'or special revenue accounts as  
appropriate'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end, before the Statement  
of Fact, a new sentence to read as follows:

'This section shall not apply to the sale of transcripts to the public  
by hearings reporters and official court reporters.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides that fees received by state officials and  
employees may be credited to special revenue accounts. It also  
provides that hearings reporters and official court reporters shall be  
excepted from the purposes of this Act.
