AN ACT Relating to Lights and Reflectors on Bicycles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 1962, amended. The first sentence of section 1962 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

Every bicycle ~~when in use in the nighttime~~ shall be equipped with a lamp on the front which shall emit a white light visible from a distance of at least 200 feet to the front and with a red reflector to the rear which shall be visible at least 50 feet to the rear.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of the bill is to insure that all bicycles shall be equipped with lights and reflectors.
