STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Providing a Full-time Office for Registration and Licenses for Operation of Motor Vehicles in the Town of Madawaska.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. Madawaska; motor vehicle registration office. The Secretary of State shall maintain a full-time office at Madawaska to carry out his duties relating to applications for registration of and licenses for the operation of motor vehicles.
- Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Highway Fund to the Secretary of State, Motor Vehicle Division, the sum of \$35,045 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:
