AN ACT Increasing Nonresident Big Game Hunting License Fees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2401, sub-§ 3, ¶ F, amended. Paragraph F of subsection 3 of section 2401 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 1 of chapter 409 of the public laws of 1971, is amended to read as follows:

F. Nonresident big game hunting ~~\$42.50~~ \$65
Permits hunting for all species including bear and deer.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase the license fee for nonresident big game hunting from \$42.50 to \$65.
