RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Convey Certain Islands in Southwest Harbor, Hancock County.

Forest Commissioner; authorized. Resolved: That the Forest Commissioner is authorized to convey the interest of the State in those islands situated within the confines of the harbor of Southwest Harbor, Hancock County, to the Town of Southwest Harbor.

STATEMENT OF FACT

These islands are very small and within sight of the shore and very little of them show at high tide. The purpose of this resolve is to permit the Town of Southwest Harbor to provide more fill for possible future parking areas, etc.
