STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Time for Filing Application for Election Recounts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 21, § 1152, amended. The first paragraph of section 1152 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

On the written application of a losing candidate in any election not later than 10 days after the tabulation of the vote is submitted to the Covernor and Council election, the Secretary of State shall permit him or his counsel to recount the ballots under proper protective regulations, subject to the following provisions:.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide for application for election recounts to be filed 10 days after the particular election.
