COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S. P. 57, L.D. 140, RESOLVE,
Authorizing the State Tax Assessor to Convey by Sale the Interest
of the State in Certain Lands in the Unorganized Territory.

Amend said resolve by striking out everything under the
caption SALEM TOWNSHIP, Franklin County and inserting in place
thereof the following:

'Plan I: Lot 50, with bldgs.
Sell to Chester Galek for \$360.92. If he does not pay this amount
within 60 days of the resolve, transfer to State Forestry Department.'

Further amend said resolve by striking out everything under the
caption ANDOVER NORTH SURPLUS, Oxford County and inserting in place
thereof the following:

'Lots 12, 13 and 14. (Excepting all but 1/2 interest in common and
undivided).

Sell to such of the heirs of Howard C. West as are interested for
\$758.07. If they do not pay this amount within 60 days of the
resolve, transfer to State Forestry Department.'
