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### AN ACT Relating to Number of Lobster Traps on Trawls in Saco Bay and Westerly, Cumberland County.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 12, § 4464, amended.** Section 4464 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

**§ 4464. —Saco Bay; Cumberland County**

It is unlawful to have on any trawl more than 3 lobster traps on one warp and buoy in ~~that any part of Saco Bay west of and westerly to a line running 150° true from the center of Spurwink River in Scarborough~~ the active light-house at Two Lights in Cape Elizabeth to the Hue and Cry Buoy.

### STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is reflected in the title.
