STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Dragging of Scallops in Gouldsboro Bay, Hancock and Washington Counties.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1959, c. 154, Chapter C, § 4, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 4 of Chapter C of chapter 154 of the private and special laws of 1959, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 104 of the private and special laws of 1969, is amended to read as follows:

Dragging for scallops in Gouldsboro Bay above or north of a line drawn from Youngs Point in the Town of Gouldsboro, easterly to Dyer Point in the Town of Steuben shall be limited only to the use of either one \pm foot drag or two \Rightarrow foot drags one combination of scallop drags not exceeding 4-feet in width.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to clarify the description of the scallop drags.
