COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 128, L. D. 152, Bill,  
"AN ACT Relating to Possession of Deer Lawfully Killed."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the 2nd paragraph  
and inserting in place thereof the following:

'A person lawfully killing a deer during the open  
season may have the same in his possession ~~during-a-closed~~  
~~season~~ until July 1st of the following year provided the  
deer has been properly registered in accordance with section  
2355. To lawfully have the deer and parts thereof in  
possession after the following July 1st, a permit  
must be obtained from the district game warden in which  
said person resides.'

Statement of Fact

The change would be a great benefit to warden service  
in combating the illegal practice of killing deer during  
the summer months.
