STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Fees and Traveling Expenses for State Humane Agents.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 17, § 1213, amended. The next to the last sentence of section 1213 of Title 17 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

For services and expenses in conducting such investigations such agents shall be paid a reasonable sum 2.25 per hour by the county in which such services are rendered and expenses incurred, and for their travel the same fees as are now allowed officers by law for the service of a warrant for arrest 10¢ per mile, but no county shall be liable to pay the fees of such agents for their travel outside of its lines.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide for State humane agents fees for services at the rate of \$2.25 per hour and travel expense at the rate of 10ϕ per mile.
