HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 131, L.D. 155, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Lights on Motor Vehicles of Baxter State Park
Rangers."

Amend said Bill by inserting before the enacting clause,
the following emergency preamble:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do
not become effective until 90 days after adjournment of the
Legislature unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the said 90-day period will not terminate until
after the tourist season and major park use, during the summer
of 1973; and

Whereas, the following legislation is vitally necessary at
the earliest possible time to safely operate the park for Maine's
citizens and tourists; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary
for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
therefore,'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end, before the
Statement of Fact, the following emergency clause:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the
preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'
