AN ACT Relating to Lights on Motor Vehicles of Baxter State Park
Rangers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 1368, sub-§ 2, amended. Subsection 2 of section 1368 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

2. **Police department vehicles.** Lights used on police department vehicles and on motor vehicles operated by chiefs of police, state fire inspectors, inland fisheries and game wardens, sea and shore fisheries wardens, **Baxter State Park rangers**, sheriffs and deputy sheriffs shall emit a blue beam of light.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to permit blue beams of lights on vehicles of Baxter State Park rangers.
