COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 62, L.D. 165, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Bilingual and Bicultural Education."

Amend said Bill in the 7th line of Sec. 2 (6th and 7th lines of
L.D.) by drawing a line through the words "having a high concentration
of such children" as follows: '~~having-a-high-concentration-of-such~~
~~children~~'

Further amend said Bill in the 8th line of Sec. 2 (same in L.D.)
by striking out the underlined words "and bicultural"

Further amend said Bill in the 9th line of Sec. 2 (same in L.D.)
by striking out the underlined word "these"

The purpose of this amendment is to permit all districts,
whose directors wish, to permit bilingual education, subject to
an annual approval by the commissioner.
