AN ACT Defining the Boundaries of Richmond's Island Sanctuary.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2101, amended. The 24th paragraph of section 2101 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, which relates to Prout's Neck; Richmond's Island; Cape Elizabeth Sanctuary, as amended, is further amended by adding at the end a new sentence to read as follows:

For the purpose of this paragraph Richmond's Island shall include only that portion of land above the high water mark.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to clarify the boundaries of Richmond's Island in reference to the sanctuary.
