STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Prohibiting Pollution of Eagle Lake, Hancock County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Pollution of Eagle Lake, Hancock County; prohibited. No person shall swim or bathe in Eagle Lake, Hancock County.

No person shall operate a boat by rowing, paddling, use of a sail or motor and no person shall operate a snowmobile or fish through the ice in that area of Eagle Lake contained within a circle, the center of which is the so-called Gate House of the Bar Harbor Water Company at the Duck Brook outlet of said lake, the radius of which circle is 1,000 feet.

Any person convicted of violation of this Act shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$50 or by imprisonment for not more than 10 days, or by both.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to prevent pollution of the public water supply of Bar Harbor.
