COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 147, L. D. 180, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to the Taking of Alewives in the Salmon Falls
and Great Works Rivers, York County."

Amend said bill by inserting before the enacting clause
the following emergency preamble:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not
become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted
as emergencies; and

Whereas, the alewife industry is an important economic
industry for certain towns in Maine; and

Whereas, the alewife running begins in the spring of the
year; and

Whereas, it is essential that the Town of South Berwick
should manage this industrial resource in the spring of 1973; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
safety; now, therefore, '

Further amend said bill in the last line before the statement
of fact by inserting before the period the following: 'subject
of 1964,
to section 3708 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes / as amended'

Further amend said bill by inserting before the statement
of fact the following emergency clause:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the

(Filing No. # 86)

preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to add an emergency to the bill.
