HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 61, L.D. 187, Bill, "AN ACT Increasing the Number of Superior Court Justices and Official Court Reporters."

Amend said Bill in section 3 by striking out in the 7th and 8th lines (6th line in L.D.) the words "to serve for a term of 7 years" and inserting in place thereof the following: '~~to serve for a term of 7 years~~'

Further amend said Bill in section 3 by striking out in the next to the last line (same in L.D.) after the word "salary" the word "of" and inserting in place thereof the following: '~~of~~ up to'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to remove the 7-year term of office thus making it an indefinite term and providing a salary up to \$12,500 in place of the full \$12,500 per year.
