AN ACT Providing for an Additional District Court Judge at Large.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 4, § 157, amended. The first sentence of section 157 of Title 4 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

The Governor, with the advice and consent of the Council, shall appoint to the District Court ~~4~~ 5 judges at large and 15 judges.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$43,750 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:
