HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 159, L.D. 201, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Possession of Firearm During Open Season on Deer after
Deer Registered.

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§3154." by adding
at the end before the Statement of Fact the following new paragraph:

'This section shall apply only to that area of the State lying
south and west of a line starting at the junction of Route 302
and the New Hampshire line at Fryeburg; thence south on Route 302 to
its junction with Route 115 in Windham; thence easterly on Route 115
to its junction with the Maine Turnpike in Gray; thence northerly
and easterly along the Maine Turnpike and Interstate 95 to its
junction with Route 395 in the City of Bangor; thence easterly on
Route 395 to the Penobscot River; thence easterly along Route 1-A to
Ellsworth; thence southerly by the Union River and southerly to the
"3-mile limit;" thence southerly by the "3-mile limit" to the
New Hampshire line.

The purpose of this amendment is to help prevent the illegal
killing of deer.
