SENATE AMENDMENT"A " H.P. 159, L.D. 201, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Possession of Firearm During Open Season on Deer after Deer Registered."

Amend said bill by inserting at the end, before the Statement of Fact, the following underlined paragraph:

'This section shall apply only to that area of the State lying south and west of a line starting at the junction of Route 25 and the New Hampshire line at Porter, thence southerly on Route 25 to its junction with the Maine Turnpike at Portland, thence northerly and easterly along the Maine Turnpike and Interstate 95 to its junction with Route 395 in the City of Bangor, thence easterly on Route 395 to the Penobscot River, thence easterly along Route 1A to Ellsworth, thence southerly by the Union River and southerly to the "three mile limit, " thence southerly by the "three mile limit" to the New Hampshire border.'

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to try and protect deer from illegal hunting in that area of the State where there are very few bear.
