HOUSE AMENDMENT " B " to H.P. 160, L.D. 202, Bill, "AN ACT  
Relating to Hunting from Public Ways."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the amending  
clause and before the Statement of Fact and inserting in place  
thereof the following:

'It shall be unlawful for any person to hunt any wild birds or wild  
animals from any public paved way within ~~any-municipality-of~~ the  
State, ~~except-with-a-shotgun-used-in-conjunction-with-ammunition~~  
~~no-larger-than-No.-6-shot.~~'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to eliminate the exception  
in the law.
