STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Hunting from Public Ways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2455-A, amended. The first sentence of section 2455-A of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 259 of the public laws of 1971, is amended to read as follows:

It shall be unlawful for any person to hunt any wild birds or wild animals from any public way within any municipality of the State, except with a shotgun used in conjunction with ammunition no larger than No. 6 shot.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This would make it unlawful to hunt from bituminous roads in unorganized towns as well as organized towns.
