COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 161, L.D. 203, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Election of Jury Trials in Misdemeanor Proceedings."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end, before the Statement of
Fact, the following:

'In any prosecution before the District Court under Title 29,
section 1312, in which the Judge of the District Court transfers the
case to the Superior Court for arraignment or disposition, the
defendant's operator's license or permit and privilege to operate a
motor vehicle in this State shall be suspended pending the trial in
the Superior Court unless the Judge of the District Court shall
otherwise order.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to assure that any defendant
under Title 29, section 1312 who elects a Jury Trial in Superior
Court will not operate his motor vehicle pending the trial.
