AN ACT Increasing Salary of County Attorney of Sagadahoc County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. That part of the 13th paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes which relates to the county attorney of Sagadahoc County, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

county attorney, ~~\$7,500~~ \$15,000;

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of the Attorney General the sum of \$13,125 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:
