HOUSE AMENDMENT " B " to H. P. 163, L. D. 205, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to the Rendering of Treatment and Services to Minors
for Drug Abuse without Parental Consent."

Amend said Bill in section 6 by inserting at the end
of that part designated "§1823." the following underlined
sentence:

'Provided, however, that such hospital shall notify and obtain
the consent of said minors' parent or guardian if such hospitalization
continues for more than 16 hours.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to insure that the consent
of the parents is required when a minor needs extended hospitalization.
