AN ACT Relating to Costs of Administration of Food Stamp Program.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 22, § 3104, amended. Section 3104 of Title 22 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 1 of chapter 463 of the public laws of 1971, is amended by adding a new sentence at the end to read as follows:

The State of Maine shall pay 50% of the cost of administering a food stamp program in any county, excluding issuing costs.

Sec. 2. P. L. 1971, c. 463, § 2, repealed. Section 2 of chapter 463 of the public laws of 1971, is repealed.

Sec. 3. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Welfare the sum of \$225,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1974 and \$300,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1975 to carry out the purposes of this Act.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide that the State shall pay 50% of the administrative costs of a food stamp program in any county.
