AN ACT Relating to Classes or Grades of Engineers' and Firemen's Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 26, § 178, amended. The last sentence of the first paragraph of section 178 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 447 of the public laws of 1971, is repealed as follows:

~~Such classes or grades shall conform to those established pursuant to Title 30, section 3204.~~

STATEMENT OF FACT

In working with those classes and grades established under Title 30, section 3204, (City of Lewiston and City of Portland) the board has found that those grades are unrealistic by today's standards.

The board desires to establish grades of engineers' and firemen's licenses which are based on plant or boiler output, pressure and temperature rather than on horsepower which is an antiquated term. Further, the board wishes to establish special grades for special situations such as heating plants, etc.
