HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 167, L. D. 209, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Membership on Board of Elevator Rules and Regulations."

Amend said Bill by inserting after the enacting clause the following:

'Sec. 1. R. S., T. 26, §431, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 431 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

The said board shall consist of -5-6 members, of whom 3 shall be appointed to membership by the commissioner, subject to the approval of the Governor and Council.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 2.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end of the 10th line (8th line in L. D.), before the period, the following 'and the 6th member shall be a licensed elevator mechanic'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end, before the Statement of Fact, the following:

'Sec. 3. R. S., T. 26, §431, amended. Section 431 cf Title 26 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by inserting after the first paragraph the following new paragraph:

The supervising inspector of elevators shall be the secretary of the board.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is:

1. To give the board the practical experience of a licensed mechanic.

2. To provide by statute a secretary to the board, which by custom is already in effect.
