IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Minimum Length of Trout in Maine Ponds, Brooks and Streams.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2553, sub-§ 2, amended. Subsection 2 of section 2553 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 169 of the public laws of 1969, is further amended to read as follows:

2. Trout. A trout less than 6 inches in length, except that there shall be no the length limit for trout taken from ponds, brooks and streams shall be 8 inches;

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to set the length limit for trout taken from ponds, brooks and streams to be 8 inches.
