**AN ACT Appropriating Funds for an International Arrivals Building at
Bangor International Airport.**

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and Resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the future growth and development of Bangor International Airport and its effects on the overall economic development of the State of Maine require immediate construction of a new facility to handle international passenger and cargo traffic through said airport; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$480,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1973, to be expended under the direction of the Department of Transportation for the immediate construction of an international arrivals building and related facilities at Bangor International Airport. This appropriation shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this Act have been accomplished.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is reflected in the title.
