AN ACT Relating to Recording Municipal Ordinances Relating to Land Control.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 33, § 662-A, additional. Title 33 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 662-A to read as follows:

§ 662-A. Municipal and control ordinances

A municipality which adopts any ordinance which relates to land control, including, but not limited to, zoning and subdivisions, shall record such ordinance in the registry of deeds in the county or registry district wherein such municipality is located.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide recording of municipal land control ordinances.
