HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 181, L.D. 223, Bill, "AN ACT  
Relating to Service Retirement of State Mental Institution  
Employees."

Amend said Bill by inserting in the 3rd line of paragraph  
"G" after the underlined word "service," the following words and  
punctuation: 'all of which must have been rendered as an employee  
of a State mental institution or an institution for the mentally  
retarded and in direct contact with the patients,'

The purpose of this amendment is to limit the bill to provide  
for continuous creditable service within mental institutions and  
the employee has to be in direct contact with the patients.
