HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 181, L. D. 223, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Service Retirement of State Mental Institution Employees."

Amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out everything after the amending clause (same in L. D.) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'G. Any member who is an employee of a state mental institution, who has the direct care of patients and who has at least 20 years of creditable service, may be retired on a service retirement allowance which is equal to 1/50 of his average final compensation. Any retirement allowance granted under this provision to a member under age 60, shall be at a reduced amount determined by applying to the retirement allowance the percentage that a life annuity due at age 60 bears to the life annuity due at the age of retirement.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment would not involve any costs of the State as it spells out the classifications to be covered and would avoid misunderstanding and confusion.
