COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 185, L. D. 227, Bill,  
"AN ACT Relating to Penalty for Not Having a License Issued  
under Fish and Game Laws."

Amend said bill by striking out everything after the  
amending clause and before the statement of fact and inserting  
in place thereof the following:

'4. Lack of license. Whoever is convicted of not having  
a license issued under chapters 301 to 335 shall be punished  
by a fine of not less than \$20, plus the cost of a license fee  
for such activity.'

Statement of Fact

It is the intent of this amendment to add to the fine for  
not having a license the cost of obtaining an appropriate license.
