**AN ACT** Relating to Penalty for Not Having a License Issued under Fish  
and Game Laws.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 12, § 3060, sub-§ 4, additional.** Section 3060 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection 4 to read as follows:

**4. Lack of license. Whoever is convicted of not having a license issued under chapters 301 to 335 shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$20. If the cost of the license is more than \$20, the fine shall be not less than the cost of the license.**

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to create uniformity for penalties regarding violations of the licensing statutes.
